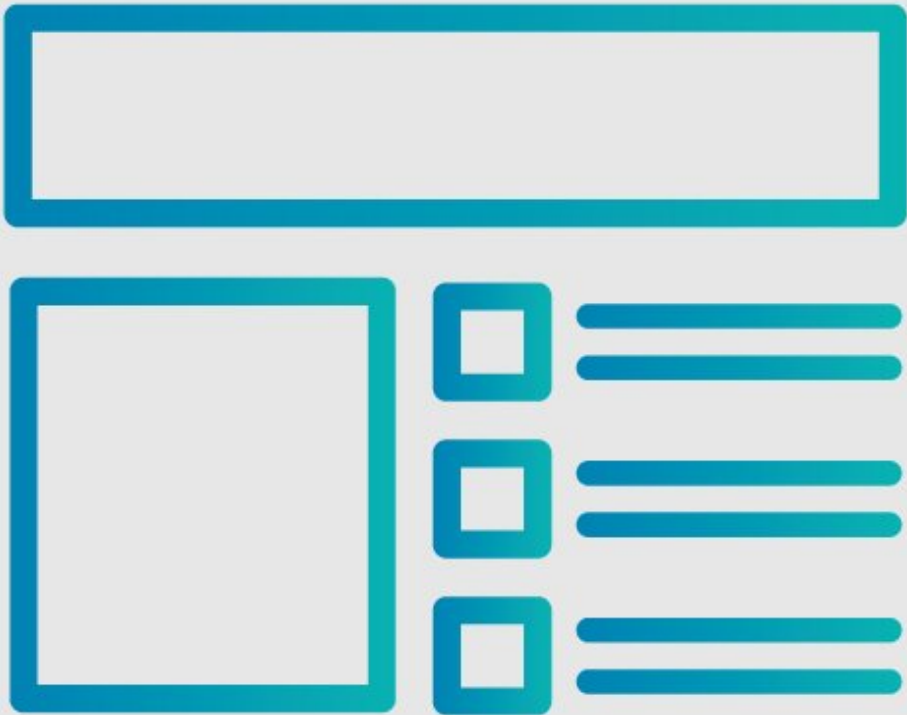

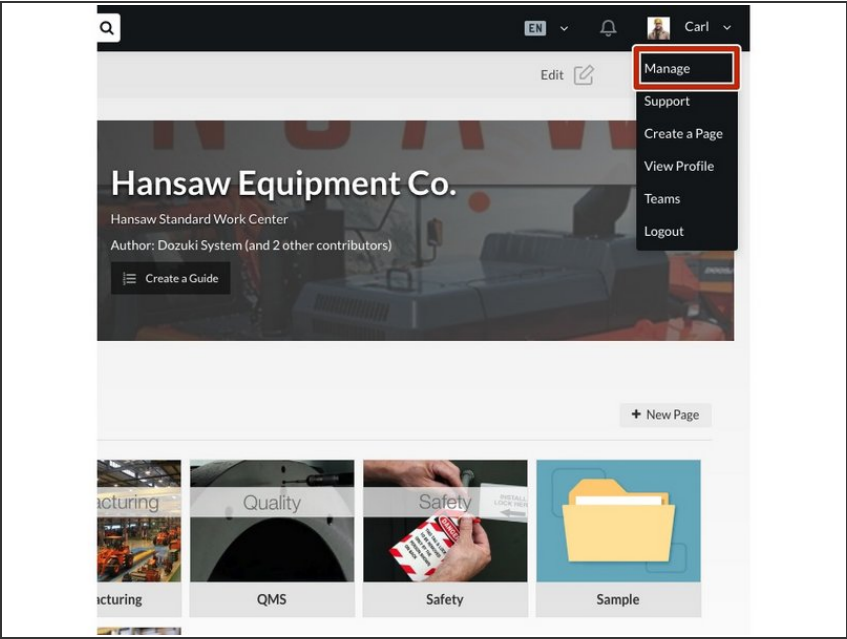


INTRODUCTION

This guide demonstrates how to customize your PDFs.

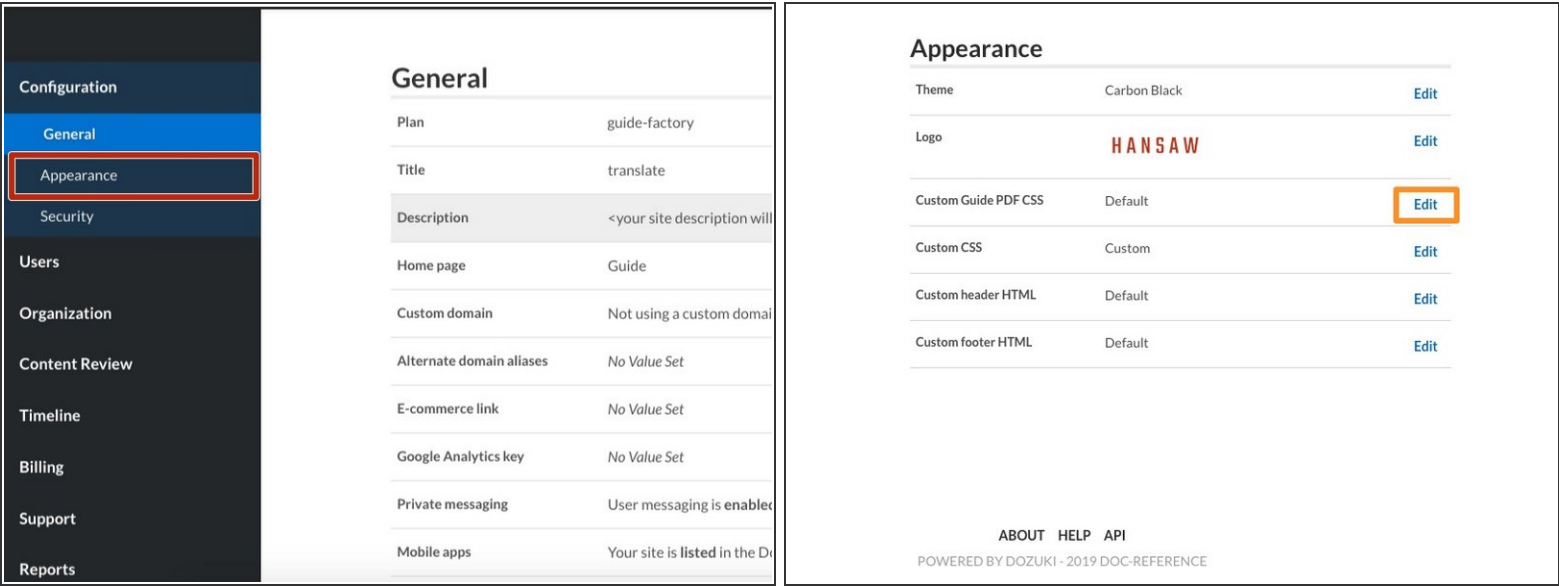
This guide shows you how to use CSS to customize the PDF output of your guide.

Step 1 — How to Customize PDFs



- To access the user menu, click on the drop-down arrow next to your name in the right of the site header and select **Manage**.

Step 2



- Select the **Appearance** subsection under **Configuration** on the side bar.
- Click on the **Edit** button in the **Custom Guide PDF CSS** section.

- You can now enter your custom CSS in the Custom CSS PDF field.
- You can also preview an HTML version of your PDF. This allows you to target specific elements of your PDF that you want to customize with CSS.
 - ① This HTML preview of the PDF allows you to use Chrome DevTools or Firefox's Firebug to see the HTML structure and stylesheets used to style the PDFs.
