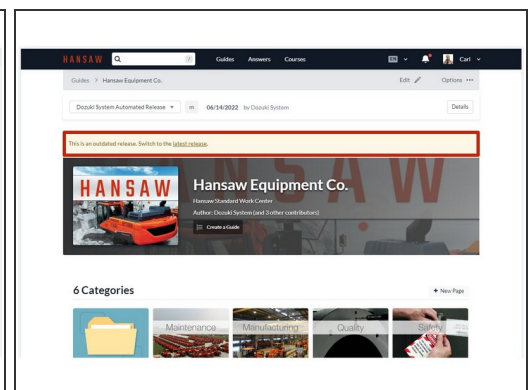
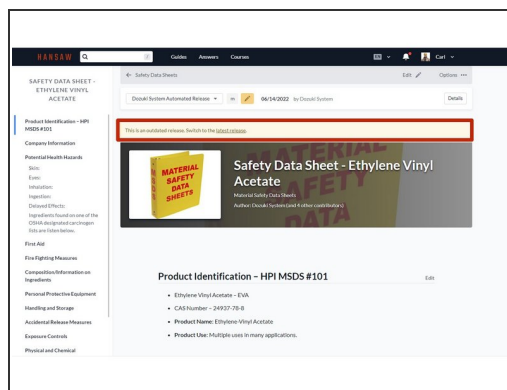
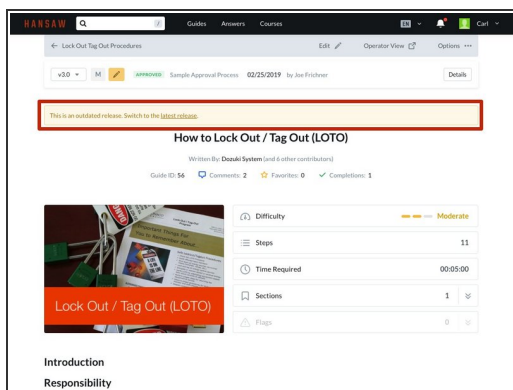
This guide demonstrates how to view past versions of a guide, wiki, or category page.

Step 1 — How to View Past Versions of a Guide, Wiki, or Category Page



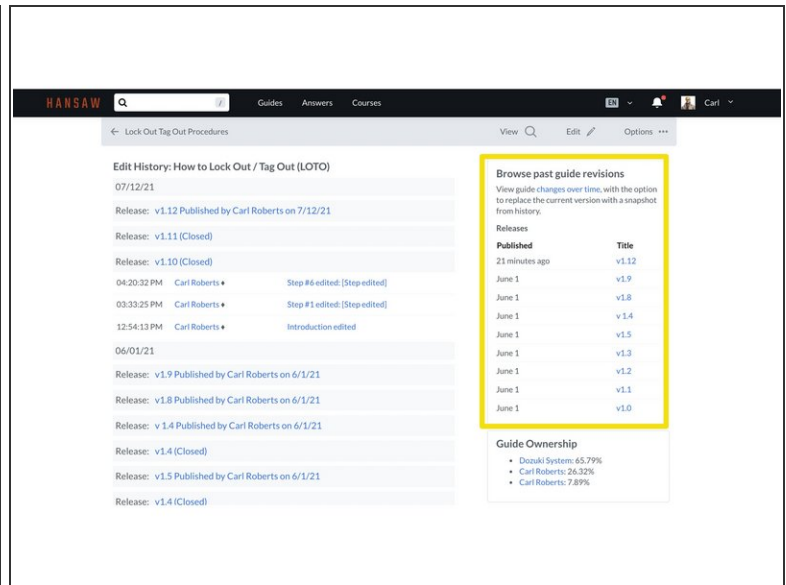
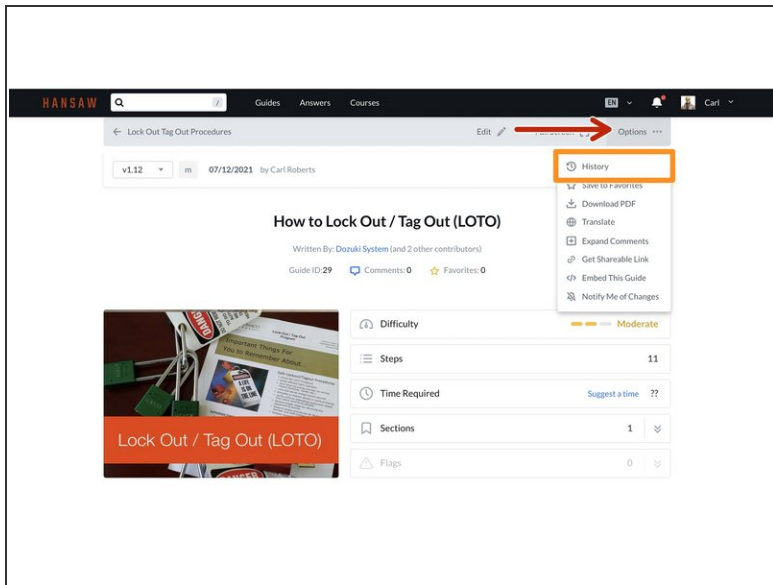
- Navigate to the guide, wiki, or category page.
- Click the version **drop-down menu** in the upper-left of the page.
- Select the version that you want to view.

Step 2



- Viewing a previous version always includes a warning, which also includes a link back to the **latest release** for the guide, wiki, or category page.
- ① Different types of pages have different layouts, but the process for viewing previous releases is the same for all three, even for your site's main page.

Step 3 — Review Past Revisions



- Additionally, you may easily review past revisions by viewing a page's history.
- Click on the **Options Menu** in the upper-right of the guide.
- Select **History** from the drop-down menu.
 - For guides, revisions are displayed as **Published** releases under the **Browse past guide revisions** section.
 - ① Wikis do not have this display.
- ① Only the most recently published version is displayed to standard users.
