


INTRODUCTION

Step 1 — Edit Guide




- Navigate to the guide that needs a flag(s).
- Click on the **Edit** button in the topright of the page, beneath the site header.


- Click inside the **Flags** field near the bottom of the Introduction page.
- Select a **Flag** from the drop-down menu.
- To narrow the list, you can also type the title of the flag you need.

Step 3 — Save Added Flags



- Your selected flags will appear above the search field.
- Click on the Save button.

Step 4 — View Flag



- Click View Draft in the upper-right of the page, beneath the site header.
