
## INTRODUCTION

## Requirements



Only administrators and authors are able to set page permissions. Otherwise, the Permission section is automatically set.

## Step 1 — Open Page Edit



- Open the page you want to change and click on the **Edit** button in the upper-right of the page, beneath the site header.

## Step 2 — Permissions Section



- Scroll down the page and locate the **Edit Permissions** section on the right side of the page. **Edit Permissions** allows you to determine the minimum reputation necessary for automatic acceptance of a user's updates.
- Use the **Sliding Meter** to select a Reputation threshold for a user's edits to be automatically accepted.
- You can also type in a **Specific Number** in the text box.
- ① Explanation of Permission Values:
  - 0 - No minimum value, no edits require reputation for immediate acceptance
  - # - Edits from people with reputation below # require Patrolling for acceptance (unless made by the guide creator or a member of the creator's team)
  - ∞ - All edits must be Patrolled for acceptance, unless made by Authors, Administrators
- Click **Save** to apply the new Permission threshold for the page.
