



INTRODUCTION


A dynamic wiki list is essentially an incomplete list. Because it's incomplete, you can keep adding wikis to it. A dynamic list searches the site; it searches for tags that are relevant to the list. This process groups all of the wikis together in list form.

Step 1 — How to Create a Wiki List



 Click on the Edit button in the topright corner of the page where you want to create a dynamic list.



(i) Under Additional Information, create a header to arrange your wiki list under a title.

- Highlight the text that will be used for your header.
- Click on the paragraph icon.
 - Select header or subheader from the drop-down menu.

Step 3




- Using the example code, insert your information into the appropriate fields.
 - For example: [wikilist|LOTO] or [wikilist|Safety]
- (i) Add wikis to your list using tags.
 - The **Tags** section is on the bottom-right of the wiki edit page.

The page that contains the wiki list must contain the tags of the wikis that are listed.

• After creating your list, click on the **Save** button.

Step 4



- Wikis that share the same tags are listed on the wiki's homepage.
- (i) Wikis must be public to show up in their respective lists for all users.
- (i) Private wikis only show in their respective lists for users who have access to that wiki.
